Hundreds of Offshore Scaffolders Sign  
CISRS Collective Grievances



## CISRS Collective Grievances have now been submitted to Stork, Cape and Bilfinger Management

Unite has now written to Stork, Cape and Bilfinger raising large collective grievances due to the employers' refusal to meet the costs associated with CISRS CPD and card renewal.

Hundreds of Offshore Scaffolders have stood up and said: CISRS CPD is mandatory, HSE endorsed, H&S training. It is unacceptable that the employer requires Offshore Scaffolders to hold a valid CISRS card while refusing to pay for the associated H&S and competency training.

No other trade is being treated this way and neither should Offshore Scaffolders.

## Next Steps

The collective grievances have been submitted. We are currently awaiting the employers' response to these submissions. However, we must also begin making preparations for a formal industrial action ballot. Once we have an indication of the way the employers are likely to react we will take the next steps required. If need be we will be writing and emailing all offshore scaffolders requesting that you update the details we hold on file for you to support a legal requirements associated with preparing a trade dispute.
