Industrial Action Ballot opens 18th June and closes 20th July.

Make sure you vote in the ballot.

The ballot for Industrial action is now open. This ballot will be a postal ballot and you should aim to post your ballot paper back as soon as possible to make sure that it is counted.

This vote is not being done electronically. You may also receive an email about the OCA pay offer. Please also vote on this but ensure that you return the Industrial Action ballot paper.

For industrial action to take place the turnout in the ballot must be above 50%. Anything less and no action will be able to be taken.

It is important that everyone votes and gives Unite the maximum amount of leverage over AKER by having a mandate for Industrial Action.

If you have not received a ballot paper to your home address by Monday 25th June then please contact the Aberdeen Unite office on 01224 645 271.

If you work for AKER but are not a member of Unite then you will not have any legal protection should Industrial Action be called.

If you want to join Unite and have a say and vote then its important that you join up by the 2nd July 2018 to ensure you get a vote in the ballot.
