Firstly, we would like to thank all those who filled out the Unite In Petrofac Survey.

The survey is now closed. We are currently taking the time to go through the responses in detail. However, an initial review of what you have told us has shown that there are some serious issues affecting a lot of Petrofac employees. For example:

- A number of you have said that you have concerns about the return of the Superpuma helicopter to service. You can back our campaign by signing the petition. We need everyone to back to this campaign. More info on Unite campaign will be issued soon.
- Many have also raised issues around the 3x3 rota and the effect it is having on health and safety offshore. An independent survey run by the Robert Gordon University will be launched soon and Unite will publish more information on this nearer the launch date of the survey.
- Issues around workload pressure, cabin occupancy offshore and parental leave have been identified. We want to look at these issues with Petrofac members in more detail.
