I am writing to ask that you support Unite the Union's demand that the Super Puma helicopter should not be used to fly offshore workers to and from offshore installations in the UK and to support the motion by Labour MSP Lewis Macdonald who is calling for a debate on the issue.

The Super Puma's record makes grim reading. It has ditched in the sea 6 times in 8 years; 65 people have been rescued from the North Sea and 33 workers have lost their lives. All were involved in travelling to or from installations on the Super Puma.

The decision to lift the ban has rightly angered the offshore workforce. A survey by Airbus and a petition by Unite have identified thousands of workers declaring that they will not put their lives at risk by flying in these helicopters again.

The Oil and Gas industry is vital to the local and national economy. They claim their most valuable asset is the workforce. Help us make them listen! Please support our call to end the use of these unsafe and hazardous helicopters and sign up to motion number S5M-07724.
